The Clifton Steamboat Museum is excited to host our fourth Student Art Contest. Art work should show the students interpretation of the theme – Heroes: Past, Present, and Future. Judges will be selected at the solo discretion of the Clifton Steamboat Museum. **Artwork must be delivered to the Clifton Steamboat Museum by 1pm, Thursday, November 1.** Artists will be notified of their selection to the exhibit by November 8. Guidelines for Submission:

- 1) Artist must currently be enrolled in grades K-12. Artwork will be presented in four categories: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12.
- 2) First place in each category will receive a Clifton Prize Pack with a cash prize for best overall.
- 3) Artwork must be two-dimensional, hand-rendered, and no larger than 9" X 12". Matted submissions will not be accepted.
- 4) Only one original, hand-rendered artwork per artist may be submitted.
- 5) Artwork must be inspired by the theme.
- 6) Artists must clearly print his/her name, grade level, and school on the back of his/her submission.
- 7) Artist must submit a completed registration form, including artist statement information, with his/ her submission. Worksheets should be neatly handwritten. The Museum is not responsible for misspelling due to illegible writing.
- 8) Registration form with student and parent signatures, MUST accompany the artwork.
- 9) Artwork will be juried on five criteria: skillful use of chosen medium, commensurate with artist's grade level; composition and design; impact of the image; interpretation of theme; and creativity.
- 10) Please paperclip your registration form to your artwork.

The Clifton Steamboat Museum, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to reject or remove any submission that fails to meet the Guidelines or that the Museum may determine to be inappropriate for display as part of the Exhibit. In consideration for acceptance of a student's artwork in the Exhibit, the Clifton Steamboat Museum will have the perpetual worldwide and royalty-free right to use any photographic (including digital) images, video, or audio related to a student's participation in or submission to the Exhibit that may be made for promotional, documentary, and/or educational purposes, without compensation to the student artist or his/her heirs or assigns.
